ITINERARY OVERVIEW

DAY 1

ARRIVE IN NAIROBI

TRANSFER: Arrive Nairobi, you will be met off your international flight by our 'Meet and Greet' service that will have a paging board with your name & will guide you through immigration, baggage collection and customs and will assist you in connecting with the representative from The Giraffe Manor who will transfer you to Giraffe Manor. The drive from JKIA to Giraffe Manor 45 minutes. ACCOMMODATION: You will spend 1 night at Giraffe Manor on a full board basis.

DAY 2

NAIROBI TO SAMBURU

TRANSFER: After breakfast, you will be transferred (15 Minutes) from Giraffe Manor to Wilson Airstrip.

FLIGHT: Depart from Wilson Airstrip at 1020 to Kalama Airstrip (Samburu)

TRANSFER: On arrival at Kalama Airstrip at 1130, you will be met by a representative from Sasaab who will transfer you (95 minutes) to the lodge.

ACCOMMODATION: You will spend 3 nights at Sasaab Lodge on a full board basis.

DAY 5

SAMBURU TO SOLIO

TRANSFER: After breakfast, Sasaab Lodge vehicle will transfer you (10 minutes) to Sasaab airstrip

FLIGHT: Depart from Sasaab airstrip on Private Charter at 1000

TRANSFER: On arrival at Solio Airstrip at 1030, you will be met by a representative from Solio who will transfer you (10 minutes) to the lodge

ACCOMMODATION: You will spend 3 nights at Solio in a luxury room on a full board basis.

DAY8

SOLIO TO MASAI MARA

TRANSFER: After breakfast Solio vehicle will transfer you to Nanyuki airstrip (45 minutes)

FLIGHT Depart from Nanyuki airstrip with Safarilink flight at 1000

TRANSFER: On arrival at Keekerok Airstrip at 1100, you will be met by a representative from Sala's Camp who will transfer you (45 minutes) to the Sala's Camp

ACCOMMODATION: You will spend 4 nights at Sala's camp in a luxury tent on a full board basis.

DAY 12

MASAI MARA TO NAIROBI

TRANSFER: Sala's vehicle to transfer to Keekerok airstrip (45 minutes)

FLIGHT: Depart From Keekerok airstrip with Safarilink flight at 1100

DAY 1 - GIRAFFE MANOR









On day 1, you will arrive at JKIA and be met by a Giraffe Manor driver to be transferred to the Manor. The drive will take approximately 45 minutes. You will stay overnight at this iconic property and meet the famous resident herd of endangered Rothschild giraffe.

You can feed the giraffe treats through the windows, give them kisses on the terrace and watch the young ones play on the lawn. The Manor is an old English style house which used to be a hunting lodge, in Nairobi's Langata suburb. It has just 10 rooms and each one is completely different, styled lovingly by the properties owners.

Whilst you're here you can also visit some of the other local attractions, shops and museums - such as the David Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage, The Karen Blixen Museum, Kazuri Beads and Matt Bronze.

Your stay here is on a full board basis for 1 night and includes Airport transfers, transportation around the Karen & Langata area (within the check-in and check-out times), all meals, house wines, house soft drinks, house beers, house spirits, laundry, wireless internet access, entrance to the AFEW Giraffe Centre and VAT.: Champagne, luxury spirits, selected wines, tips, health insurance, massage treatments and personal effects

DAYS 2-5 - SASAAB









Majestically situated on the high banks of the Ewaso Nyiro River, Sasaab commands breath taking views across the arid landscape of the Northern Frontier District towards the jagged peak of Mt Kenya, and offers a truly exceptional safari experience in an area renowned for its variant species.

The accommodation consists of nine luxurious, Moroccan-style tents each with its own plunge pool. The facilities also include a large swimming pool and spa for that truly pampering experience. Activities include game walks, night drives, camel riding and Samburu cultural visits including visits to the local markets.

Sasaab offers a true wilderness experience with opportunities for excursions into the Samburu Reserve renowned for its large herds of elephant and the Samburu Special Five – Grevy's Zebra, Reticulated Giraffe, Beisa Oryx, Gerenuk and Somali Ostrich.

Your stay here is on a full board basis for 3 nights and includes all meals, house wines/beers/soft drinks, laundry, game drives, walking and fly camping (By prior arrangement only). Extras: Champagne, luxury spirits, selected wines, treatments in Spasaab, tips, health insurance and personal effects.

DAYS 5-8 - SOLIO LODE









This modern and exclusive lodge is located on the Solio Game Conservancy between the majestic slopes of Mount Kenya and the Aberdare Mountains. Internationally recognised as the most successful breeding reserve in Africa for rhino, both the black and white, it is also home to Eland, Oryx, Buffalo, Lion, Leopard, Cheetah and a plethora of other species.

The lodge has just six cosy and luxurious rooms, each en-suite with large glass pane windows to take in the panoramic views of the landscape which is framed by Mount Kenya. Each room has a private lounge area warmed by a corner fire, as well as large bathrooms with double sink, bath and shower. The rooms are designed for warmth (Solio is high in altitude and can be cold at night), as well as outdoor living with each having a deck in front for relaxation during the day.

Your stay here is on a full board basis for 3 nights and includes all meals, all house drinks, laundry, game drives, walking, mountain biking and horse riding.

Extras: Champagne, luxury spirits, selected wines, tips, health insurance, scenic helicopter ride, massage treatments and personal effects.

DAYS 8-12 - SALA'S CAMP









Located in the heart of the Maasai Mara on the banks of the Sand River, Sala's Camp offers front row seats to watch the annual Great Wildebeest Migration unfold.

Ideally positioned with spectacular views towards the Northern Corridor and Serengeti, guests are ensured a classic East African safari experience in a prolific wildlife area.

Sala's upholds a long tradition of safari under canvas with stylish but simple accommodation reminiscent of early mobile safaris. From your tents you will be able to enjoy an abundance of birdlife and wildlife and the indigenous environment. The camp prides itself on its hospitality, and from this wonderful location one can easily explore the vast Maasai Mara Reserve. A warm camp atmosphere and Maasai guided activities ensure an unforgettable safari.

Your stay here is on a full board basis for 4 nights and includes all meals, house drinks, laundry, game drives, bush breakfasts, sun-downers.
